Educational Essay Scholarship Program

The Agland Co-op Educational Essay Scholarship Program offers four scholarship awards of \$1,500.00 to a meritorious senior student who demonstrates commendable dedication to their studies in the surrounding area schools of Glasgow & Nashua, Wolf Point, Poplar and Froid

Eligibility Criteria:

- Students who qualify must enroll in an accredited higher education institution (such as a college, university, or vocational school).
- Preference will be given to recipients from farm families and those studying agricultural fields. If no
 eligible candidates from farm backgrounds are available, the scholarship will be awarded to non-farm
 families with an ag related focus.

Selection Process:

- The selection committee, consisting of the high school counselor and two faculty members (such as teachers and/or administrators), will oversee the evaluation process.
- If there's no counselor at the high school, Agland Co-op will handle the selection process, essays can be mailed to Agland Co-op C/O Scholarship Program 300 US HWY 2, WOLF POINT MT 59201

Criteria for Selection:

- Students are required to submit an essay (200-300 words) about themselves and their plans for their future ag education.
- The decision is based on the effort put forth by the individual.
- Students who go above and beyond to maintain better than average grades receive top consideration.

Scholarship Allocation:

- The selected scholarship recipient's high school must provide the following information to Agland Co-op administration:
 - 1. Recipient's full name
 - 2. Address of the Higher Educational institution
 - 3. Student's identification number for that institution if applicable
 - 4. Essays from all the students who applied for the scholarship program

Disbursement:

• The scholarship funds will be directly remitted to the educational institution chosen by the recipient for the upcoming autumn term.
